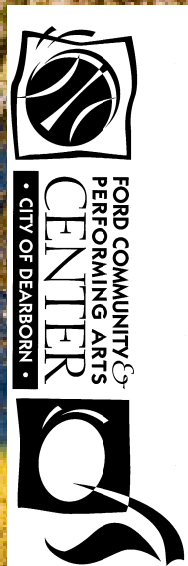

## MUSIC

**DEARBORN COMMUNITY CHORUS (DCC)** established in 1963 by the Dearborn Recreation Department, welcomes all, ages 16 and older, who love to sing. For many years, the Dearborn Community Chorus has provided a place for people from surrounding communities to come together to share music. The group rehearses weekly with artistic director, Marcus LaPratt from September through May, and presents two major performances at The Center in December and May. The DCC also travels abroad, performs for community events, and plans an annual local performance tour.

**DEARBORN YOUTH SYMPHONY (DYS)** was formed in 1975 to provide young performers with symphonic experience and to foster interest in instrumental music. The DYS has been an important step to greater musical achievement for many young musicians in our community. With support from the Dearborn Recreation Department and parent volunteers, the artistic and assistant directors of DYS continue to challenge and nurture young musicians. Members range from 8 to 21 years of age and represent over 25 communities within the metropolitan area. The DYS rehearses and performs at the Ford Community & Performing Arts Center. To its' members, the DYS offers solo/concerto competitions, scholarships, and grants. The DYS is comprised of a concert orchestra, symphony orchestra and flute choirs.

**VANGUARD VOICES (VV)** is a 70-voice, adult mixed chorus sponsored by the Dearborn Recreation Department and is choir-in-residence at Henry Ford Community College. Its artistic director, G. This auditioned group, whose members' experience ranges from dedicated amateur choristers to music professionals, rehearses weekly from September to May and appears in several concerts throughout the year. Vanguard Voices performs a *cappella*, with Vanguard Brass Ensemble, with area orchestras, and with other choral groups. This classical chorus presents the best in traditional and contemporary choral music.
